

PRIVACY POLICY - Information notice on the processing of personal data

PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF REGULATION (EU) 2016/679 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation)

2. Types of data collected

The categories of personal data collected and processed when you browse www.turismobusca.it are the following:

- personal data you provide to us when you contact our office to provide you with the information you requested;
- information about your browsing on www.turismobusca.it;
- information collected through cookies.

We inform you that Comune di Busca does not process personal data relating to minors. By accessing www.turismobusca.it and using the services offered by Comune di Busca, you declare that you are of legal age.

Failure by the User to provide certain personal data may prevent this Website from providing its services.

3. Purposes of the processing of collected data and relative legal basis

Statistical analysis and surveys for the purpose of improving our offer and our services	Consent of the data subject

4. Methods of processing

The Data Controller processes Users' personal data by adopting appropriate security measures aimed at preventing unauthorized access, disclosure, modification, or destruction of personal data.

The processing is carried out using computer and/or telematic tools, with organizational methods and logic strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Data Controller, in some cases, access to the data may be available to subjects, duly designated by the Data Controller, involved in the organization of the website or external entities (such as third-party technical service providers, mail carriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communication agencies) appointed also, if necessary, as Data Processors by the Data Controller. The updated list of Processors can always be requested from the Data Controller.

5. Data transfer

In the event that personal data is transferred outside the European Union, for technical-operational purposes and to ensure high continuity of service, the Data Controller ensures that the transfer will take place in compliance with the conditions set out in Chapter V of the GDPR, without prejudice to the other provisions of the Regulation itself.

6. Retention period of personal data

We keep your personal data for a limited period of time, which varies depending on the type of activity that involves the processing of your personal data. Once this period has expired, your data will be permanently deleted or otherwise irreversibly anonymized.

Your personal data is stored in compliance with the terms and criteria specified below:

In any case, for technical reasons, the termination of processing and the consequent permanent deletion or irreversible anonymization of the relative personal data will be definitive within thirty days from the terms indicated above.

7. Additional information about processing

7.1 Defense in legal proceedings

The User's personal data may be used for defense by the Data Controller in court or in the stages leading to its possible establishment, against abuse in the use of the same or connected services by the User.

The User declares to be aware that the Data Controller may be required to reveal data upon request of public authorities.

7.2 Specific information notices

At the User's request, in addition to the information contained in this privacy policy, this Website may provide the User with additional and contextual information notices regarding specific services, or the collection and processing of personal data.

7.3 System logs and maintenance

For operation and maintenance purposes, this Website and any third-party services used by it may collect System Logs, i.e., files that record interactions and which may also contain personal data, such as the User's IP address.

7.4 Information not contained in this policy

More information in relation to the processing of personal data can be requested at any time from the Data Controller using the contact information.

8. Exercise of rights by Users

The individuals to whom the personal data refer have the right at any time to obtain confirmation of the existence or non-existence of the same from the Data Controller, to know its content and origin, to verify its accuracy or request its integration, erasure, update, rectification, transformation into anonymous form, or the blocking of personal data processed in violation of the law, as well as to object in any case, for legitimate reasons, to their processing. Requests must be addressed to the Data Controller and/or the DPO.

9. Changes

We reserve the right to partially or fully modify this Privacy Policy or simply update its content, e.g., following changes in applicable law. Therefore, the user is invited to regularly consult this Privacy Policy to know its latest updated version so as to be always informed about how personal data is collected and used by the data controller.
